

## **PREACHING GOD'S WORD IN KENYA**

**Mission trip to Kenya from 4 to 27 February 2020**

**"Then they went out and preached everywhere, and the Lord worked with them, and confirmed His word with the signs that followed." (Mark 16:20)**

**"You prophesied about me in 1994," Pastor Elija said, "that the Lord Jesus called me as pastor. I would feed, teach, and heal many in Jesus' Name. I, the Lord, have spoken it and will do it. "**

**We had gone to Kenya on his invitation to preach in his churches. In the same year of the prophecy, he founded his first church in eastern Nairobi, the Deliverance Church in Ruai. A large church that can accommodate three thousand visitors and also 13 daughter churches.**

**The program consisted of three-day revival meetings in various of these churches, where we would preach about conversion, healing, and baptism in the Holy Spirit.**



**Deliverance Church Ruai. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues. (Acts 2: 4)**

**This church is also a prayer center. There are rooms to pray and even the opportunity to spend the night for those who come from far. Pastor Elija believes that the power of the New Testament churches in the book of Acts was in their persistent prayer and fasting.**



**At the Leaders' Conference in the Deliverance Church Mihango, everyone was blessed with a prophecy, because whoever prophesies speaks for their strengthening, encouragement and comfort. (1 Corinthians 14: 3) At the women's meeting in the Deliverance Church Ruai, it was about Jesus, who is the good Shepherd and the sheep hear His voice. (John 10)**



**Deliverance Church Kamulu. Repent and believe the Gospel. (Mark 1:15)**

**In the rural Lemuru lies the beautiful Anglican St. Julian Retreat Center, where we were allowed to relax for a day. A stark contrast to the hectic and not harmless city of Nairobi with around five million inhabitants.**

**The land has been plagued for a long time by a locust plague that destroys the crops. When you consider that many people have to live on what their piece of land yields, that means no food for them. Also due to climate change, the rains are not on time. After sowing the maize, they stay out or come later. There is also a kind of weed sprouting everywhere that is not known before and has overgrown the grass for the animals.**

Enough reasons to call for repentance and return to the only living God, the Father of the Lord Jesus Christ, who gave His life on the cross of Golgotha for salvation and deliverance for everyone who believes. There is forgiveness and redemption through the blood of Jesus that purifies us from all sin. (1 John 1: 7). Jesus did not stay in the grave, but rose from the dead on the third day and has said: "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me will live, even if he has died. "(John 11:25)

We know that God's word that comes out of His mouth will not return to Him empty, but will do what He pleases and achieve the purpose for what He sends it. (Isaiah 55:11)

A disadvantage was that the house where we stayed was at the end of the runway of the international airport, resulting in day and night roaring engines of aircrafts taking off. In his service in 2 Corinthians 6: 5, Paul mentions the days without food and nights without sleep. I said to Eltjo: "Now we know what that last one is!"
